As part of our Year 6 Ancient Egypt topic we are holding an Ancient Egypt Day on Friday 18th November 2011. The day will involve a visit from an Egyptologist (from a local museum) who will spend half a day with each class. She will give the children the opportunity to handle genuine artefacts that are thousands of years old and even perform a mummification (on a doll) for each class.

During the second half of the day the children will be led by their class teacher in other Egyptian themed activities.

The children will be allowed to dress up for the day – nothing major required (an old pillowcase will be quite suitable or even a loo roll).

We are asking for a contribution of £4 to help fund the day.
