BIKEABILITY LEVEL 2 (YEAR 6)

Monday 9th – Friday 13th October 2017

Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find attached to this letter, details of the Bikeability Level 2 Course offered to Year 6 cyclists during school time.

There are seven courses available on the above dates. Each course comprises five 1.5 hour sessions. The cost of this course is £30.00, however there is a reduced cost of £11.50 if your child receives free school meals.

If you would like your child to take part please complete the reply slip AND Surrey County Council consent slip attached and return them to school in a sealed envelope, together with £30.00/£11.50 to cover the cost of the course. You can pay on ParentPay, alternatively you can pay by cash or cheque (payable to "Queen Eleanor's School Fund"). All forms and payments must be received **by Friday 7th July**.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. If your child has a music lesson, dentist appointment, or other similar activity during the day, please make a note of the details on the slip attached.

Bicycles need to be in a roadworthy condition and should be stored in the bike rack at the front of the school. We would prefer you to send your child's bike in on a daily basis. If you are unable to do this, the bike may be left overnight, but please be aware that we do not have anywhere to secure the bikes and the gates are unlocked from 3.15pm until later in the evening and again from 7.00am until the start of the school day. If you would like your child to leave their bike overnight, please indicate on the reply slip below but please accept that it is entirely at your own risk.

While there is no legal requirement for the children to wear a helmet, we strongly recommend that they do so as they will be cycling on public roads.

You may also wish to send in a tracksuit or similar and appropriate outdoor clothing (including a waterproof jacket) for your child to change into for the course.

As soon as the courses are confirmed we will be sending out details of time slots.
