### **CLOTHING:**

- Warm clothing – it is still March!!
- Sensible footwear for walking.
- Waterproof Jacket.
- Changes of underclothes.
- Socks
- Nightclothes.
- Casual clothing for evening.
- Indoor shoes – plimsolls/trainers.
- Toilet things plus towel.

The children need to be able to carry their own bags. It may be useful for you to pack the case with your child so that they know what should be repacked to take home and to attach a contents list to the inside of the bag/suitcase. Please name everything!

### **OTHER EQUIPMENT:**

- One case only.
- One day bag.
- Reading book, quiet games – e.g., playing cards (no electronic games please).

- Carrier bag(s) for dirty clothes/shoes, etc.
- No mobile phones.

**FOR THE JOURNEY:**

A packed lunch for Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> March, in disposable wrappings, to include a drink in a refillable, named and leak-proof bottle. No sweets please.

**TIMETABLE:**

Arrive at school at 8.30am. If the weather is dry then we will meet outside the main entrance, otherwise please enter the school via the main entrance and go straight to the hall.

Estimated time of return 6.00pm Wednesday, 21<sup>st</sup> March to school.

The school will be notified should there be any change affecting our return and we will put a board outside the main entrance and post an update on the school website.

**POCKET MONEY:**

Pocket money should be handed to your group leader, in a clearly labelled purse/wallet on the day of departure. We suggest a maximum of £10.00, in small denominations so that spending can be spread across the 3 days.

**MEDICINES:**

Please hand in any medicines to Mrs Radley, with clearly labelled instructions, on arrival at the school.

**CAMERAS, WATCHES:**

These may be taken at owner's risk. We cannot accept responsibility.

**DISCIPLINE:**

Since safety is paramount at all times on School Field trips, we feel you should be aware of our policy on discipline:-

1. During day time visits and overnight, children are always supervised by school staff.
2. If a child repeatedly refused to act in a responsible manner and accept guidance, he or she would be asked to remain at the Centre under supervision and miss out on a day's activities.
3. If the above steps did not appear to work, we reserve the right to ring the child's parents and ask for his or her removal.

Although we sincerely hope that points 2 & 3 do not arise, we feel that it is prudent to have clear guidelines accepted by everyone.
