YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO LITTLE CANADA, ISLE OF WIGHT 2013

We are pleased to be able to write to you with details of our Year 6 residential trip for 2013. From Monday 8th – Friday 12th July 2013 a group of Year 6 pupils, supervised by members of QE staff, will stay at Little Canada, a PGL site on the Isle of Wight.

The visit will be a multi-activity course, encouraging team building and leadership skills in a fun and supportive environment. There are a huge variety of activities, which could include abseiling, quad biking, kayaking and archery to name a few. The staff at the centre are experts in their respective fields and are skilled in introducing children to their particular area of expertise. As with any school activity great attention will be paid to the safety and welfare of the children as well as to their educational development.

The accommodation consists mainly of 4 – 8 bedded log cabins with en-suite facilities. There is also a communal room.

The cost including transport and insurance will be in the region of £415. The cost reflects the excellent standard of expertise, equipment, food and accommodation available.

If you would like your child to participate in this visit **please complete the reply slip below and enclose a deposit of £50**. Places are available for everyone but we need you to commit to the trip and return the slip below with your deposit by **Wednesday 23rd May** in order that we can secure the booking with PGL. Please put the slip and money in a sealed envelope, marked with your child's name and "**Little Canada 2013**", to be handed to the class teacher at registration. Please note that this deposit is not refundable unless the visit has to be cancelled due to lack of support. Cheques should be made payable to '**Queen Eleanor's School Visits Fund**'. Alternatively you can pay on ParentPay.

As always, payment will be arranged in instalments and full details of the trip will be discussed at a meeting with parents and children nearer the time.
