## Year 5 Residential Visit to Normandy 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to be able to write to you with details of our proposed Year 5 trip for 2018. Next year the trip will run from Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and will be supervised by members of staff from Queen Eleanor's. The topic for the Summer Term is World War II and to enhance this trip we will be visiting Normandy, France. Our trip will include visits to the Pegasus Bridge Memorial Museum, the Juno Beach Centre, the American military cemetery and more. We will be staying at the Chateau du Baffy which is close to all the sites we will be visiting.

The cost of the trip will be in the region of **£300**, including transport and insurance. Please be aware your child will require a full passport and European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).

If you would like your child to participate in this visit **please complete the attached reply slip indicating your interest**. Places are available for everyone but we need you to commit to the trip and return the slip by **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2017** in order that we can secure the booking. **We do not require any payment at this stage**. The Governors have decided we need 75% of the year group to commit to the trip in order for it to go ahead. **Once we know enough of the year group has committed we will write to request a non-refundable deposit of £50.00 to be paid by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March.**

**If we do not receive forms from the required number of children by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March, the trip will not go ahead.** We will, of course, give you reminders before the deadline.

As a result of feedback from other residential trips we would like to clarify the situation regarding deposits. The deposit payment date is set to meet the deposit deadline imposed by our tour company. The date is not negotiable. If the trip goes ahead payment will be arranged in instalments and once confirmed, a payment schedule will be sent out to you.
