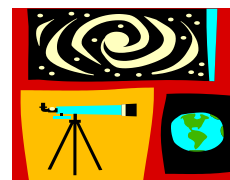
**Parking...** Please remember that parents/carers must not park on the school premises at the beginning or end of the school day.
