What a first full week back to school at QE. Inevitably I am going to start by talking about our Ofsted Inspection on Wednesday this week. As a school we knew that a visit from Ofsted was imminent due to the fact we were two terms over the time we should have been seen following our last inspection in January 2013. We believe QE is a good school and the inspection begins with the Inspectors thinking the same. Their focus was to find evidence that supports our assessment of the school and if they have concerns that we are not good or outstanding, a second day is added to the inspection. The result of the inspection cannot be shared until the letter is written by the inspector but obviously the inspection only lasted a day so you can draw your own conclusion from that.....

A key part of the inspection is feedback from stakeholders in the school. We were very pleased to see so many of you respond to the survey particularly at such short notice. In all, we had 107 submissions to Parents View which represents nearly a third of our parent body so thank you very much to those of you who took the time to give feedback.

Following the Ofsted inspection, we had the AGM of the PSA. This was a very well attended event and we were pleased to see so many new faces. If you missed the meeting and would still like to be involved in the PSA, please contact the joint Chairs Howard Moss or Andy Moloney or speak to the school office. Volunteers are the life blood of the PSA and we are always on the look out for new members both for the committee and to help at events. There are a large number of events planned for this term so if you are able to help, please get in touch. I have included a picture of our new courtyard which the PSA funded. Their contribution was over £27,000 and the new area will be a much needed resource in the future so a massive thank you to everyone involved in raising the money.
