Year 3 Trip to Butser Ancient Farm

Dear Parents,

As part of our topic on the Romans, Year 3 will be visiting Butser Ancient Farm on Friday 12th October. The visit will include practical activities.

The children should wear old clothes with sensible shoes such as trainers, walking boots or wellies if wet. Please bring a spare pair of shoes in a named carrier bag in case shoes /boots get too muddy for the return trip! They will need a waterproof coat, in case of rain. We recommend wearing lots of layers as it can get quite cold and windy.

They will also need a packed lunch. Please can we remind you to check carefully that this does not contain nuts. In addition to this, we suggest that they bring a water bottle and healthy snack for when we arrive at Butser.

If your child has free school meals, they can have a packed lunch supplied by the school kitchen. This **MUST** be ordered by Friday 5th October, and cannot be ordered on the morning of the trip. If you would like to take up this option, please indicate on the reply slip below.

The children can bring some pocket money to spend in the gift shop. This should be a maximum of £3 and should be brought in on the morning of the trip. Please put it in a named purse or envelope.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school after registration and returning in time for the end of the school day.

We would ask for a voluntary payment of £16.00 to cover the cost of the coach, activities and entrance fees. Please complete the reply slip below and return it, along with your payment, in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, class and "Butser" to your child's class teacher. Please make cheques payable to *Queen Eleanor's School Fund*. Alternatively, you can pay on ParentPay if desired.

We have room for 3 parents to accompany us, could you please indicate if you are willing and able to join us on the reply slip. For the safety of the children, we require that all helpers are CRB checked. If you are unsure about whether you are CRB checked or need to check the validity of the dates of your existing CRB, please come and speak to the office.
