Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Trip to the British Museum

As part of our topic on 'The Egyptians', Year 6 will be visiting the British Museum on **Tuesday 28th November**.

The children should wear school uniform (including a sweatshirt/cardigan) and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a packed lunch in a rucksack, as they will need to carry this all day. In addition, we suggest that they bring a water bottle and healthy snack for when we arrive. Please can we remind you to check carefully that your child's food does not contain nuts. If your child has free school meals, they can have a packed lunch supplied by the school kitchen. This **MUST** be ordered by Friday 10th November, and cannot be ordered on the morning of the trip. If you would like to take up this option, please indicate on the reply slip below.

The children can bring some pocket money to spend in the gift shop. This should be a maximum of £5.00 and should be brought in on the morning of the trip. Please put it in a named purse or envelope in their rucksack.

Please note that we shall be travelling by coach, **leaving school promptly at 9.00am** (please **do not be late** or your child will not be able to go on the trip) and **returning** to school at approximately 5.00pm (traffic permitting).

We would ask for a voluntary payment of £8.50 to cover the cost of the coach. There are no charges for entrance to the Museum. Please complete the reply slip below and return it, along with your payment, in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, class and "British Museum" to your child's class teacher. Payments can be made via ParentPay, cash or cheque (payable to "Queen Eleanor's School Fund").

We have room for 5 parents to accompany us. We would like parent volunteers to independently lead a group of 9-10 children around the Museum to complete a selection of activities. If you are able to join us on the trip and have a DBS clearance through QE, please let your class teacher know. If you need to arrange a DBS check please contact the school office.
