**Pupil Premium funding will directly support the following planned objectives:**

1. All pupil groups, including those with SEND, Pupil Premium, FSM, Lower\Middle ability make progress at and above the National Average.
2. The percentage of children making more than expected progress exceeds National Average for Reading, Writing and Maths.
3. Continue to close the in school progress gap between FSM and non-FSM in Reading Writing and Maths.
4. Introduce targeted interventions which are strategic and measureable for all groups of pupils.

**Objective 1:** All pupil groups, including those with SEND, Pupil Premium, FSM, Lower\Middle ability make progress at and above the National Average.

One to One tuition	30 minutes, 3 times a week over a set period of 12 weeks	<b>£19,250</b>
Teaching Assistant support for Mathematics	Support from our teaching assistants in maths sessions every day across the school, either through a 1 to 1 or small group setting. Additional teaching assistants were employed to support these children in a range of groups.	<b>£36,300</b>
Cumbria Reading Intervention	The Cumbria Reading Intervention is an intensive programme designed to speed up the development of a child's early literacy skills. It involves the linking of the teaching of reading with the development of a child's phonological skills. Each programme is specifically planned for an individual child and is delivered by a teaching assistant on a 1:1 basis. The programme involves 48 sessions of support delivered over a 12-week period.	<b>£1,600</b>
