## YEAR 3 HOOKE COURT RESIDENTIAL FINAL INFORMATION AND KIT LIST

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have attached a kit list, listing all items the children need to bring to Hooke Court. Children will need to bring all the items listed on the kit list into school on the Wednesday morning. These items should be in a soft sided holdall **that they can carry** (not a suitcase). They should also bring a rucksack containing their lunch for Wednesday and a small healthy snack for mid-morning. Please ensure that your child has disposable containers so that they do not have to bring home dirty lunchboxes or containers later in the week.

On the Wednesday, children should arrive at school in sturdy shoes suitable for walking, trousers and be wearing their school jumpers. They need a packed lunch, a NAMED WATER BOTTLE and rucksack; they should also have a waterproof coat and if they wish they may bring a scarf, hat and gloves – weather dependent, although it may be advisable to pack these anyway.

Please note that some of the activities the children are participating in are outside and therefore they will get dirty. It is best to send old clothes, with full length trousers and long sleeves to avoid scratches from foliage. Please also ensure that all items are named – including socks and underwear as in previous experience, even the tidiest children lose items of clothing. This way, everything can be returned to its owners.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please provide travel sickness tablets for both journeys and make their teacher aware of this IN ADVANCE of the trip.

There is no need to send mobile phones or electronic equipment such as cameras or ipods as there will not be opportunities to use them. It is recommended that precious items such as jewellery or favourite clothes are left at home as well.

As there is a small shop on site, children may also bring a maximum of £5 in change only.

During the visit the children will be participating in a variety of activities looking at daily Roman life, what it was like to be part of the Roman Army and the things the Romans brought to Britain. There will be plenty of practical opportunities and lots of exciting, memorable activities. As well as being educational, this is a real opportunity for the children to develop socially and we will be embracing this aspect of the trip as well.

We will be holding a meeting on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> March, at 3.30pm in the hall, to go through this in further detail.

## KIT LIST

Please attach a packing list so that your child is aware of what to pack again at the end of the trip. We suggest that they pack their bags at home themselves before they leave so that they are familiar with **HOW** to pack the bag as well as what it contains.

**Please also ensure that all items are named – including socks and underwear as in previous experience, even the tidiest children lose items of clothing. This way, everything can be returned to its owners.**

- Toiletries bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, flannel, hairbrush etc (no aerosols please).
- Towel for showering and washing
- Night clothes
- Enough socks and underwear (plus spares)
- At least 2 T-shirts or tops with long sleeves.
- 1 or 2 sweatshirts or jumpers (warmer wear is suggested)
- 1 or 2 pairs of trousers (warmer wear is suggested)
- Sturdy shoes or wellies (which they will be wearing on Monday)
- Another pair of shoes/trainers
- Indoor shoes/slippers
- Cuddly toy
- Torch
- Large plastic bag/bin liner for wet/dirty clothes
- Gloves, hat and scarf
- Reading book(s)
- Small games such as cards or colouring books for quiet time

Inside their day bag/rucksack should be:

- A waterproof jacket (and trousers if you wish)
- Lunch
- A small healthy snack
- Drink in a named water bottle

To wear on Wednesday:

- Sturdy shoes for walking
- Warm trousers
- T-shirt or warm top
- School jumper
