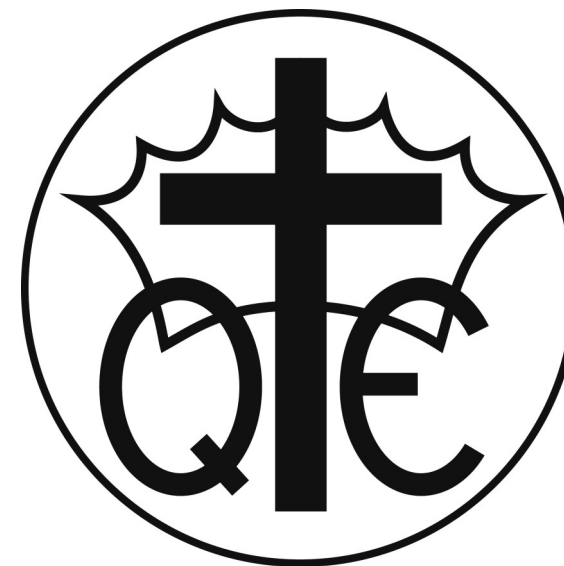
On their PE and Games days, children need to come to school wearing their PE kit.
