Oak National Academy Online Classroom and Resource Hub

Oak National Academy is a new collection of high-quality lessons and online resources. Backed by the Government (DFE), it has been created in response to school's currently being closed to the vast majority of pupils.

The website offers free access to teachers, delivering video lessons, quizzes and worksheets. Available for both primary and secondary levels, it covers a range of subjects. All the lessons are ordered so your child can learn along a clear plan. There will be new lessons and resources each week.

Queen Eleanor's suggest you use this as an additional resource alongside the work packs created by your class teachers. The use of this website is not mandatory as we appreciate not all families will have access to technology/internet access for children to use this at all times.

Please be aware that the foundation/topic subject lessons on the Oak National Academy do not follow the topic that Queen Eleanor's would normally teach your children. For example, the Modern Foreign Language (MFL) lessons taught on the website are Spanish and the children at Queen Eleanor's learn French. However, you are welcome to use these lessons as you wish with your children.

At present the resources are for pupils who usually access their schools' curriculum in mainstream education, from Reception through to Year 10, without significant support or adaptation. The website is currently working on providing activities for children who require adaptations to the curriculum. Families can access any year group on this website so feel free to have a look at other year groups if the lessons are too easy or too challenging.

Each Oak National Academy lesson will be an hour long, with elements such as a quiz, a video explanation from the teacher and a worksheet. You do not need to print the worksheets out as they appear in screen for children to complete onto paper. You can use this website on a tablet or phone that have access to the internet.
