BEFORE LEAVING HOME ON MONDAY 11TH JULY

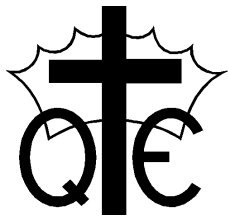
- Please ensure that your child has sun cream applied.
- Please ensure that any necessary medication and travel sickness tablets are administered at the correct time.
- Travel sickness tablets for the return journey should be handed in as per the details below.

WHAT TO BRING FOR THE JOURNEY

- Your child will need to bring both a **snack** and a **packed lunch on 11th July**.
- As usual, we ask you to ensure that all food is **nut free**. Please use disposable packaging, as everything will be thrown away (no glass bottles).
- A small backpack with a waterproof coat/jacket, sun hat and sun cream in it.
- A small amount of money (£2.50-£3.50) in a named purse or wallet for an ice cream. (Please note that this is in addition to pocket money for the trip mentioned below).
- Water bottle.
- Small travel games / reading book.

ON ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL ON MONDAY 11TH JULY: MEET IN HALL

- All children are to **register** with **Miss Watkins & Miss White**.
- All **medicines** to be handed in **by parents/carers** to **Miss Warburton**. Please make sure all medicines are clearly named and that a pink medicine form is completed along with them.
- If your child uses an inhaler, please ensure that 2 are provided: 1 for the child to keep with them and a spare for the adult in charge. (This applies to the blue inhalers only. If your child uses a brown inhaler, only one is required which will be kept by the adult in charge and administered as per the pink form instructions).
- All **pocket money** is to be handed to **Miss Wood**. This is to be no more than £10 and handed in in the brown envelope that will be provided by the school. Please label this envelope clearly with your child's name and the exact amount of money therein. Please do not send in any notes as this makes the 'banking' very difficult. It would be greatly appreciated if the money could be sent in £1.00 and 50p coins.
- After all of the above has been completed, children will be sent for a final toilet visit before departure at 9am.



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KIT LIST (Please ensure that all items are clearly labelled)

General

- 1 case or holdall, clearly named, with a contents list attached to the inside
- **1 sleeping bag and pillow**
- Washbag containing soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.
- 2 x towels (one for washing, one for water sports)
- Hairbrush / comb
- Black sack / carrier bags for dirty washing
- Reading book / playing cards / pocket games (if desired)
- Torch (for evening activities)
- **NAMED** purse / wallet

Cameras and watches may be brought on the trip at the owner's own risk.

Clothing

- 3 or 4 pairs of trousers (avoid jeans as these get uncomfortable when wet)
- 2 or 3 pairs of shorts
- At least 3 t-shirts or polo shirts
- 2 x long-sleeved t-shirts (some activities require arms to be covered)
- 2 x warm jumpers / sweatshirts
- 1 x light sweater / fleece
- Underwear (enough for 4 days)
- Socks (enough for 4 days & 2 spare pairs)
- Nightwear
- Swimming costume (one piece – no bikinis)
- Swimming goggles (if required)
- Party / disco clothes (one set)
- Waterproof trousers (if desired)

Footwear

- 2 x pair of comfortable (not new) trainers or walking shoes for activities (these may get muddy / wet)
- 1 x pair of trainers / shoes for indoor and evening use
- 1 x pair of water shoes or old trainers for water sports activity
