## 2022 Year 6 Production: The Rocky Monster Show

As you will be aware, rehearsals are well underway for the Year 6 production; 'The Rocky Monster Show'.

This year, we will be offering a choice of three performances for families to attend:

**Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July: matinee performance 1.30pm**

**Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July: evening performance 6.30pm (previously advertised as 6pm)**

**Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July: evening performance 6.30pm (previously advertised as 6pm)**

It is essential that all children involved in the production are present for all performances. On the performance evenings, the children should return to school at **5.45pm**. It is extremely important that the children are at school by this time to ensure that all hair and make-up can be completed on time. **If for any reason your child is unable to attend a performance, please can you e-mail the office as soon as possible to alert the Year 6 teachers.**

At 5.45pm, the children should go straight to the Year 3 classrooms where there will be a member of staff to look after them. If your child arrives before the time given above, we will not be able to let them into school as there may not be a member of staff available to supervise them. We expect to finish at about 8.30pm. Your child will be dismissed from the hall, so if you are not in the audience, please come into the school entrance foyer to collect your child once the play has finished. We will not be able to allow any child to leave unaccompanied without written permission. Please indicate your child's going home arrangements on Parent Pay: **Year 6 Production Arrangements**.


Entrance to the event is by ticket booking only as our hall seating is limited to comply with fire regulations. We are only able to offer limited tickets for all performances and therefore have **a 4 ticket per family limit – with only 2 evening performance tickets per family**. Please encourage those family members who can, to attend the matinee. There will be a waiting list (first come, first served) for additional tickets which will be allocated after the ticket request deadline of Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July.

**Please consider when booking, that younger QE siblings will have an opportunity to watch the play during school on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July.**

To avoid any confusion, we have created separate event codes for each performance. To re-iterate: all families are limited to 4 tickets overall. The matinee show is the only one where you can book all 4 tickets together. All families are only entitled to 2 evening tickets overall. These can either be taken together on one evening, or one per evening. You may wish to book two evening tickets and two matinee tickets.

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July: evening performance 6.30pm – cse73

Tickets to the event are free of charge, however any voluntary donations towards the cost of the production will be most gratefully received. Any donations can be paid via Parent Pay – **'Year 6 production voluntary contribution'** (we are unable to accept cash donations).

The PSA will be running a cash/card bar on both evenings. This will be open before the production and during the interval. If anyone is able to help serve drinks on either night (volunteers still get to see the show in its entirety!), please indicate on Parent Pay and we will be able to reserve your seat (a booked ticket is still required though).

Doors will open to parents at 6pm to allow you time for a chat and refreshment before the show.

Please note the Year 6 children are allowed to come into school late on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July following the performance. **All children must be in school by 10.20am at the latest.** Please let us know your intentions on Parent Pay.

In Summary:

- All children taking part are expected to be present at all performances
- Children to arrive at school by 5.45pm
- Doors open to adults at 6pm
- Cash bar available before show and during interval.
- No ticket, no entry
- Tickets to be booked on School Interviews
- Voluntary donations to be made on Parent Pay : **'Year 6 production voluntary contribution'**
- Notification that your child will be later to school on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> and Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July as well as bar volunteers to be completed on Parent Pay: **Year 6 Production Arrangements**
