



How to use Oak National Academy

1. Access the website <https://www.thenational.academy/>
2. This will take you to this home screen:



3. Click on classroom in the top right-hand corner. Which will bring up the following screen:



The **Subject** button gives you an option to choose a lesson based on what subject you would like to do e.g. Maths, English

The **Schedule** button gives you an option to follow three 1-hour lessons per day. One Maths, one English and one Foundation subject per day. You do not have to do all three lessons every day. You can choose which subject you would like to do.

4. For both options you will need to choose your **child's year group**. You can choose any year group. If the work is too challenging, try the year group below. If the work is too easy go onto the next year group.

5. Each lesson usually contains an initial quiz to see how much the children already know. Then a video led by a qualified teacher, an independent task and finally another quiz to see what the children have learnt.
6. If you want to skip or go back to an activity, then you can use the button at the bottom of the screen to move on or go back if needed.



Please be aware that the foundation/topic subject lessons on the Oak National Academy do not follow the topic that Queen Eleanor's would normally teach your children. However, you are welcome to use these lessons as you wish with your children.

For example:

- The Modern Foreign Language (MFL) lessons taught on the website is Spanish and the children at Queen Eleanor's learn French.
- Year 5's topic in the first week is The Tudor's which would not normally be the history topic in Year 5 at this time.
