Dear Year 6 Families,

Day out: End of SATS treat – Friday 13th May

As an end-of-SATs treat, we are planning a day out for the children on Friday 13th May. This will consist of a trip to Stoke Park where the children will enjoy a picnic and a range of teacher-led activities, e.g. rounders, football etc. with their friends. We will be walking to and from Stoke Park on the day and will be setting off promptly at 9:00am.

Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the walk, weather and activities (e.g. sportswear and trainers).

Children should bring a nut-free snack, packed lunch and a water bottle. If your child normally has a free school meal, and you would prefer the school provide a packed lunch, please indicate this on Parent Pay.

Please can we ask that you log on to Parent Pay by no later than **Wednesday 4th May** to consent for your child to take part in this trip. This payment item is labelled 'Year 6 SATS Treat'.

During the afternoon, the children will have the opportunity to buy an ice cream. If you would like your child to have an ice cream, please provide them with no more than £5 for this. We will be back at school by 3:15pm.

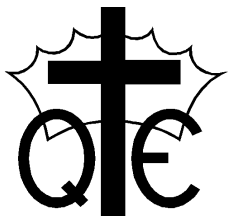
Each class will also have the opportunity to participate in an hour session at Wild Wood over the course of the day at a cost of **£15 per child**.

Please note that the Wild Wood activity is **not** compulsory. If your child does not wish to take part, they can spend more time enjoying the other activities in Stoke Park.

If your child would like to take part, please carefully read the information below:

Wild Wood Activity - £15.00 per child

If your child would like to take part in the Wild Wood activity, we ask that you pay the **£15.00** fee via Parent Pay. This will be on a separate Payment Item from the trip consent, labelled 'Year 6 Wild Wood' and we ask that BOTH this and the 'Year 6 SATS Treat' items are completed on Parent Pay.

If we do not receive consents and the £15.00 fee payment for this item, we will assume your child will NOT be taking part in the Wild Wood Activity.

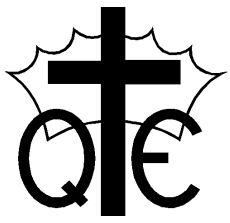

In summary:

Friday 13th May – the whole year 6 group will go on a trip to Stoke Park. All parents to complete consent on Parent Pay (Item 'Year 6 SATS Treat').
