

Our Marking Code

Look carefully at these symbols. You may see them appear in your book....

S

This **S** stands for secure and it means you really understand something and are confident enough to show someone else how to do it!

NMP

This stands for **N**eeds **M**ore **P**ractice, which means that you understand what to do but need a bit more practice to make sure you are confident.

NS

This means that you are really **N**ot **S**ure about something and need it explained again. Don't worry your teacher is there to help you.

?

If your teacher puts a question mark next to your work it means they don't really understand why you have written something; or that they can't understand what you have written. Can you look carefully at your work and see why they are puzzled?



Your teacher will put a circle around any incorrect or missing punctuation.

Sp

If you see **Sp** in the margin of your book it means you have made a spelling mistake somewhere on that line. Your teacher may underline the mistake or write the correct spelling next to the word.

//

This symbol shows you where to start a new paragraph.

C

This **C** stands for comment. It shows that your teacher has talked to you about your work in class.

W

This **W** stands for writer. It means that someone has written a piece of work out for you.

P

P will be written next to any work you have done with a partner.

G

G shows that you have worked in a group.

A

If you have been working with an adult you will see an **A** next to your work.



A dot means an answer is incorrect.



A tick means an answer is correct.
