In your persuasive text include:

- An introduction: tell them the purpose of your letter
- At least 3 clear reasons why they should be looking forward to starting Year 5. Try to support your reasons with facts and detail. Each reason should be a paragraph.
- A conclusion that summarises your reasons and your purpose for writing
- Persuasive devices, e.g. rhetorical questions, repetition, facts and statistics, rule of 3, descriptive language and boastful adjectives, counter-arguments, quotes etc.
- Remember to lay out your letter like a letter!

Brainstorm ideas for your letter here.
Introduction (Try using a rhetorical question or two!)
Reason 1 (Think about how you will start this paragraph)
Reason 2 (Could you use a conjunction to link this paragraph, e.g. Furthermore, In addition, Also)
Peaces 2 (Toute link this paragraph as well)
<u>Reason 3</u> (Try to link this paragraph as well)
Conclusion (summarise your 3 reasons and repeat your message. Could you end with something that rhymes?)
