

- Maths is taught daily for an hour in whole class mixed ability groupings. We use the White Rose Mastery approach in maths.
- Each area covered will involve fluency, reasoning and problem solving.
- Homework will support what has been done in class that week. Homework will be mental maths weekly. It would also help to continually practise timestables with your child at home.
- Two maths evening will be held in the Autumn term by Mr Papworth for you to learn about the calculation methods we teach and our mastery approach to teaching maths.



- Writing is taught in whole class, mixed ability groups.
- We cover a wide range of topics throughout the year, including story writing, setting and character descriptions, non-chronological reports, letter writing, diary writing and poetry.
- We build most of our English units around a high quality text and use talk for writing.
- Spellings are taught in class.

Spelling homework is sent home every two weeks and then tested at the end of the two week period on the Monday.

- It is extremely important that you listen to your child read three times a week and record this in their homework diary.
- Comprehension skills will be taught during daily Guided Reading lessons, as well as spelling reinforcement, phonics, grammar and punctuation tasks.
- Miss Walton (our English lead) will lead an English evening in the Autumn term.

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- We will provide the children with a coloured reading book during the first two weeks.
- When they become a 'Free Reader' they will be able to use our new sign in system to take out their books as you would in a public library.
- Your child is also allowed to take a book from our library to borrow and read alongside their coloured reading book if they wish to. This will need to be returned before they are allowed to take a new one.

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P.E and swimming

- ▶ PE will be taught by a P.E coach for 3K and 3T.
- ▶ 3G will be taught by Mr Guest (our P.E lead).
- On P.E days, your child will need to wear their P.E kit to school for the whole day (this is 2 x a week).
- We will give you a timetable in September and let you know when your child's P.E days are.
- When the weather is warm, the children are taught swimming in our school's swimming pool. They will need to bring in a bag, towel, swimming costume/ shorts and goggles.

Equipment

- All children should bring, in a suitable and <u>named</u> pencil case:
- Writing pencils and handwriting pens (blue or black)

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- Sharpener
- Rubber (suitable size)
- Ruler
- Pritt Stick (not coloured or PVA glue please)
- Whiteboard pen (preferably black)
- Coloured pencils

Water

- Children need to bring a NAMED water bottle into class which they will have access to throughout the day
- This may be refilled throughout the day
- Please do not send anything other than water



A typical QE morning

- Arrive between 8.30 and 8.45 the children walk up the drive on their own and come into class
- 8:50am register (any letters that the children bring in are handed to the class teacher at this time)
- 9:25am Maths lesson
- 10:20am break time (children can have a healthy snack outside on the playground)
- ▶ 10:35 English lesson
- 11:40 Guided Reading
- ▶ 12:10 Lunch

A typical QE afternoon

- 13:10 come in from lunch and afternoon register taken
- 13:15 afternoon lesson 1 (PE or other foundation subjects)
- 14:15 afternoon lesson 2 (PE or other foundation subjects)

History/ Geography, French, Science, Music, Art, DT, PSHE, French and Music are taught weekly- your child will be provided with a timetable in September

- ▶ 3:00 Story and packing up for the end of the day
- 3:15pm meet your child on the playground outside their classroom. They must tell their teacher they are leaving and who they are leaving with.
