Bikeability Level 1 (Year 4)

Tuesday 20th April 2021 - Friday 23rd April 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be able to proceed with our scheduled Bikeability week. This training is suitable for those who have just learned to ride and no longer use stabilisers. It is not suitable for those who have not yet learned to ride a cycle. Please find attached to this letter, details of the Bikeability Level 1 Course offered to Year 4 children during school time. **Please note: as we are taking consent via ParentPay you do not need to return the Surrey County Council consent form.**

Level 1 Bikeability is a one-day course, available on each of the above dates. Each course is for a maximum of 10 trainees and runs from 9.15am to 12.15pm. There will be two courses running concurrently each day. The cost of this course is £9.00 per child. If your child receives free school meals, the cost is £4.00.

If you would like your child to take part, please log on to ParentPay to complete the consent and settle the course payment. In order to secure a place, all consents and payment must be received no later than **Friday 19th March**.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and the school office will send confirmation of your assigned course date by Wednesday 31st March. If your child is unable to attend on a specific dates (for example if they have a medical or any other prearranged appointment), it is essential that you inform the school office at the time of booking.

Although the whole of this course takes place on the school playground, bicycles need to be in a roadworthy condition. We ask that you carefully read the attached 'Bike Check' sheet from SCC in good time to ensure your child's bike is in suitable condition. On the day of your child's course, please store their bicycle in the lower school bike rack outside the hall via the year 3 & 4 entrance.

While there is no legal requirement for the children to wear a helmet, we strongly recommend that they do so.

Please make sure on the day of your child's course, they come to school wearing clothes and shoes suitable to ride a bicycle.

As soon as the courses are confirmed, we will send out details of course allocations.
