## **BIKEABILITY LEVEL 2 (YEAR 6)**

**Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2021 or  
Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find attached to this letter, important details of the Bikeability Level 2 Course offered to Year 6 cyclists during school time. We strongly urge you to read the attached information carefully.

If you would like your child to take part, please log on to ParentPay to complete the consent and settle the course payment. In order to secure a place, all consents and payment must be received no later than **Friday 14th May**. By signing your child up on ParentPay, you are completing the consent process and **do not** need to send the Surrey County Council form back into school.

Each course comprises five 1.5-hour sessions. Due to the inset day on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June, the course sessions running the first week, will take place over four days instead of five, for a slightly extended time each day. The cost of the course is £15.00, however there is a reduced cost of £4.00 if your child receives free school meals.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and the school office will send confirmation of your assigned course date by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May. If your child is unable to attend on a specific date (for example if they have a medical or any other prearranged appointment), it is essential that you inform the school office at the time of booking. Those who have music lessons with Surrey Arts will be allocated a course time that will not affect their music lesson.

Bicycles need to be in a roadworthy condition and should be stored in the bike rack at the front of the school. We would prefer you to send your child's bike in on a daily basis. If you are unable to do this, the bike may be left overnight, but please be aware that we do not have anywhere to secure the bikes and the gates are unlocked from 3.15pm until later in the evening and again from 7.00am until the start of the school day. If you would like your child to leave their bike overnight, please indicate when consenting on ParentPay but please accept that it is entirely at your own risk.

**While there is no legal requirement for the children to wear a helmet, Queen Eleanor's school policy states that helmets are mandatory for those taking part. Only those wearing a helmet will be able to take part.**

Please make sure on the day of your child's course, they come to school wearing clothes and shoes suitable to ride a bicycle.

As soon as the courses are confirmed, we will send out details of course allocations.
