Dear Parents/Carers,

Year Six, 3-day non-residential trip to Sayers Croft : 5th, 6th and 7th July 2021

It is with deep regret that due to the uncertainty surrounding COVID-19, we were unable to go ahead with our Year 6 PGL residential once again this year.

To ensure that the children receive the send-off they deserve, we have various leavers' treats and activities planned and will be sending out details of these in the coming weeks.

This year, our predominant team-building event will take place over three consecutive day trips to Sayers Croft, Ewhurst. These dates, for the entire year group, are as follows:

Monday 5th July

Tuesday 6th July and

Wednesday 7th July

Although not a residential, this will be treated as one trip; therefore, children are expected to attend every one of the three days and cannot attend on chosen days at will.

The visit will be a multi-activity 'primary to secondary transition' course, encouraging team building and leadership skills in a fun and supportive environment. There are a large variety of activities, which include shelter building, stream walking, high ropes, bouldering and orienteering, to name a few.

Children will be transported to and from Sayers Croft by coach, leaving by 9.30am and will return to school by 3.45pm each day.

Year 6 after school activity clubs will NOT go ahead on these dates. Cricket/Rounders club fees will be refunded for Monday 5th July in due course.

Children should bring a nut-free packed lunch and snack as well as a water bottle each day. If your child has free school meals, they can have a packed lunch supplied by the school kitchen. If you are eligible, and would like to take up this option, please indicate in the relevant field on Parent Pay at the time of booking.

We will send out a full kit list nearer the time.

The overall cost for the three days is **£50.00** per child. This is a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of the coaches and all activities. We ask that this payment be made on Parent Pay along with your consent and medical information necessary to confirm your child's place on the trip by no later than **Tuesday 8th June 2021.**

The Governors have decided we need 75% of the year group to commit to the trip in order for it to go ahead. Please note, if we do not receive sufficient interest or payments, the trip will not go ahead.
