

## Information for residents and businesses

East Meads, Guildford will need to be closed for 24hrs a day for 5 days whilst we carry out our reconstruction work outside numbers 26 and 28.

**Vehicle access to houses within the direct works area will not be possible for the duration of these works, this is due to the depth of reconstruction making it unsafe to allow vehicles through this section. If you need access to your vehicle, please park it outside of the working area. The houses with access affected will receive a separate letter.**

## Roadworks during COVID-19 restrictions

We are carrying out these works in line with central government and COVID-19 safe working practises and in accordance with the CLC Site Operating Procedures, endorsed by Public Health England. Our sub-contractor will have appropriate procedures in place to ensure their staff can comply with government advice. We would ask that you please respect these workers as they deliver these highways services. We will continue to keep Surrey moving and all key routes will remain open and safe for key workers. ### Delays in work and updates

### Parking

It is essential to keep the works area free from parked vehicles, please find alternative locations to park, utilising drives and nearby roads as much as possible. We appreciate this is not always easy however it prevents us needing to return to the road to carry out additional repairs, or for us to have to tow your vehicles to nearby roads. If you have any special requirements, please speak to the team on site. You will still be able to park on your drive and access to drives will be maintained; but there may be a delay getting on and off through the works. Please allow extra time for journeys.

### Noise

There will be some noise, but we will try to keep this to a minimum.
