Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to inform you that your child has been selected to represent Queen Eleanor's in District Sports on Tuesday 22nd June at Guildford Spectrum. This is an exceptional honour and they should be proud to be representing their school in the Guildford Schools District Sports. Selections were made based upon children's performances during tryouts. A great deal of time was spent observing the children and considering their skills and abilities when making the selections.

Due to current Covid-19 restrictions, we are unable to take the children by coach, so we ask that you make the necessary arrangements to collect your child from QE and transport them to and from the event at Guildford Spectrum. At the end of the event, please collect your child from the QE staff on site at Guildford Spectrum. **Due to the circumstances there will only be one spectator allowed per child, although we are hopeful this may change.**

Children will be provided with QE team sports kit to wear to the event. This will be handed to them the night before and they should attend school wearing the sports kit. **Please ensure these are washed before returning them to school as soon as possible.** If hot, it is advisable the children come to school wearing sun cream, ensure they have a hat, plenty to drink and a snack for the afternoon. If the weather forecast is poor, children should bring suitable clothing such as raincoats or jumpers. Please send these in a bag with your child's name on and the school name.

Please ensure your child has his/her trainers in school every day in the run-up to the event, just in case we have the chance for some lunchtime practices before the event.

Please could we ask that you send your child to school with a packed lunch on Tuesday 22nd June if they will be taking part in District Sports. This will ensure that we can run the lunchtime process as smoothly as possible and that all children can eat their lunch prior to being collected for the event.
