Moving to Secondary School

I am aware that our Year 6 families will be in the process of visiting Secondary Schools and starting the application process. We encourage you to submit secondary application forms by **Friday 19th October 2018** as this is the Friday before half term. You are encouraged to apply online at www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions in order to prevent delays with postal applications. Secondary applications will be accepted up to **31st October 2018**. Applications submitted after the **31st October 2018** will be considered as late unless they are submitted late 'for good reason' by the **12th December 2018**. On the **1st March 2019**, Junior and Primary schools will be able to log in to SAM to view the destination school of your child.
