House and Sports Captains...

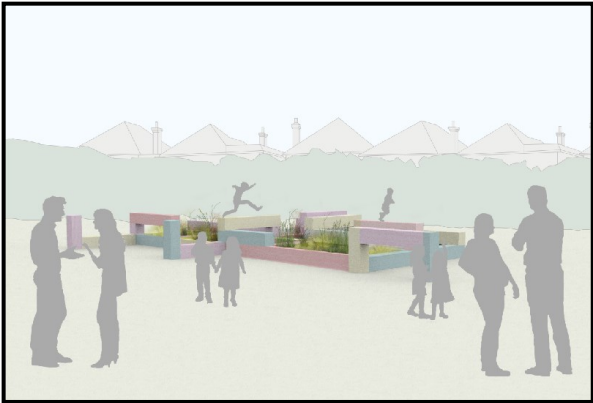
