Share a Pencil Day... On Wednesday, Queen Eleanor's participated in Share a Pencil Day which is an initiative that more than 80,000 children from 400 schools took part in last year. We started the day with a whole school collective worship, where the children were made aware of the reasons why millions of children globally are still missing out on education and why that matters. Sports Day... Reminder that our Sports Day this year will take place on Tuesday 11th June. Year 3 and 4 parents will be invited to attend the races in the morning and Year 5 and 6 parents in the afternoon. Families will be asked to sign-in at the gate on arrival at school. Lunchtime for the children will be as normal and families can return for the afternoon events if they have children in Years 5 and 6. During the event, the PSA will be running a stall for refreshments for adults only. The programme for the day will be sent out the first week after half term with timings of the races, which we will strictly adhere to.

Swimming Gala... On Saturday 15th June, the GCSC Schools Festival will take place at the Spectrum. There will be six swimming and fun races for years 1-3 in the teaching pool, and 25m individual swimming and team fun races for years 3-6 in the competition pool, individual strokes and front crawl relays. There will be no accumulated points from races, simply medals for the winners, certificates for all and discount vouchers provided by the Spectrum for use of their facilities.
