Sports Day...We were so disappointed to have to cancel our Sports Day on Tuesday but as you can appreciate we really did not have any other option. We are hopefully going to be able to hold the running races on Monday 22nd July 2019, weather permitting. This will be followed by a family picnic hosted by the PSA to which you will all be invited. Further details of this will follow nearer the time. The children did have a very enjoyable morning taking part in a variety of sports activities on the playground, hall, gym and throwing events on the top field. The bottom field (where the running track is situated), was absolutely water logged. The points that the children accumulated on this morning will be added to the running race results at the end of the half term. As always our children behaved beautifully and we all enjoyed a fun morning.

Parking... We are still experiencing problems with parking and dropping off children outside of school. Please park with consideration to our neighbours and do not block people’s driveways or stop on the yellow zig zag lines outside the school premises. **As always, the children’s safety is paramount and we are becoming more and more concerned that there will be a serious accident if this continues.** Please can I remind you that Surrey Police have confirmed that if you witness any incidents of dangerous driving or parking, you should report them to Surrey Police by calling 101. Residential Trips... From September 2019, we will only be offering two residential trips: Ironbridge in Year 4 and the Isle of Wight in Year 6. This has not been an easy decision and where it has been a luxury to be able to offer a residential in every year group in the past, we have now had to look at the current financial climate. Because of this, the SLT decided, with the support of the Governors that a residential trip could only take place if a certain percentage of the year group signed up for the trip. Unfortunately this has not happened on more than one occasion and so we have made the decision to limit the number of residential trips we offer. This has not been a decision that we have taken lightly and are aware many families will be disappointed.

Summer Concert... On **Thursday 4th July at 7pm**, we will be holding a Summer Concert in the school hall. We are delighted that some of our children have decided to take part and we look forward to their performance on this evening. If your child plays an instrument or enjoys singing and has not signed up for this event and you think that they would like to join in, please ask at the office for a letter with the details and permission slip.

Please can you ensure that if your child has decided to play a musical instrument, they practise this and remember to bring in their instrument on the rehearsal day and the day of the performance.

On the day of the performance, we would like the children to arrive at school at **6.30pm, wearing black/white clothing**. We anticipate that the concert will not last longer than an hour but we will update this in the newsletter nearer the time. Families will be invited to attend the concert and take up seats in the hall from **6.45pm** onwards. Please note that all children will need to be collected after the concert and will not be allowed to walk home alone.
