



## Welcome Back...

What a glorious start to our new half term. It has been lovely to see the children back on the field and enjoying the great weather at break and lunchtime. This is an exciting half term with a variety of different events and residential trips. We are also looking forward to sharing the Easter story with the children in preparation for the Easter festival.

### Internet Safety...

Queen Eleanor’s has been contacted regarding the recent media stories about Momo. We have been advised that Momo has been around the last 18 months and therefore is not new. It was originally an app which has now been removed and the inappropriate videos are now being distributed via WhatsApp, YouTube and online gaming (live streaming). A simple tip is to turn off ‘auto play’ on YouTube and ensure that your contact details are hidden on WhatsApp. Also, make sure the ‘no fill’ option is ‘on’ within Fortnite and all settings within your Xbox and PlayStation are closed. We advise that you continue to supervise what your children are watching, whatever it may be and remind your children that no one can make them do anything that worries or scares them. We would also like to remind you that the minimum age range for WhatsApp is 16 years old and 12 years old for Fortnite. We have made the decision not to share this information in an assembly as we feel that many of the children will know nothing about this, however, if a child asks us we will explain the same to them. All year groups will continue throughout the year to learn about Internet Safety and how to stay safe online.

### Mobile Phone Policy...

Please can we remind you that children should not be bringing in mobile phones to school unless they are walking to and from school alone. If children need to bring in a mobile phone, they need to take them to the school office at the start of the day and collect them as they leave school.

### Book Week...

We are very excited for our Book Week next week. We start the week with a visit from the author Ed Wicke. During the day, the children will enjoy a presentation and be able to ask him questions following this. Ed will be available after school on Monday in the hall, where you will be able to select and purchase books and get them signed. On Thursday, children will be invited to come to school in their pyjamas. We encourage the children to wear sensible shoes for outdoors, but they may choose to bring sturdy slippers for inside. On Friday it will be our annual dress up as a book character day whereby each child is invited to come to school dressed as a book character. Each class will be given a prize for the best costume! The Travelling Book Company will be visiting during the week and children will have the opportunity to browse the books during the school week and purchase books after school on Friday. As part of Book Week, we are also running a story writing competition across the school. Children will have until Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March to write their stories and we would encourage as many as possible to join in!

### Book Look...

On Thursday 7th March, the school will be open between 3.15pm and 7.00pm for you to have the opportunity to look at your children’s books prior to Parents’ Evening. The School will be closed at 7.00pm. Staff will not be available on this afternoon to discuss the progress of your children but Parents’ Evening will be the following Wednesday. As children will still be on site, we ask that you enter and exit the school via the school office.
